

ESOL Classes: Fall 2 2022

The Adult ESOL Program provides basic English language and life skills instruction to Maryland residents whose native language is not English. Students must be at least 18 years old. Students with F1 or J1 visas cannot take classes in this program. Covid-19 vaccination is required to take in-person classes. All classes are free except for Advanced ESOL (\$100 fee).

Fall 2 2022 ESOL Class Application Instructions

- 1. There is no online application form. All students must apply in person.
- 2. Choose your class schedule and location/format. Go to that location on the date listed. Do not bring children with you.
- 3. All new students must return for a placement test the day after they apply.
- 4. If you are in a Fall 1 ESOL class, talk to your teacher about how to apply for Fall 2.
- 5. Fall 2 classes are only weekdays in the morning. There are no evening or Saturday classes in Fall 2. The Spring 2023 session has evening and Saturday classes.
