The Institute requires:

- A Bachelor's degree as a prerequisite to admission

- A significant willingness and preparedness to engage in challenging academic work
 - Successful completion of the three core noncredit courses and one additional course each running 40 hours, in
 - Methods of Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (Required)
 - o Assessment and Evaluation in the ESOL Classroom (Required)
 - Understanding Second Language Acquisition (Required)
 - Teaching Reading Skills to ESOL Learners
 - o Grammar and Linguistics Rules for an Integrated Approach to Adult ESOL
- Successful completion of classroom observations
- Completion of all classes with a grade of "B" or higher in order to earn a Certificate of Completion.

Additional coursework may be added to the program as the needs are identified.
